

Memorandum of Understanding

Dear Dr. Sinchai,

ONE Software Company Limited (OSCL) is pleased to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and formalize the cooperation between our company and the Prince of Songkla University College of Computing (PSU). We believe this to be a positive step toward a mutually beneficial relationship. We look forward to working with you, the university staff, and the students over the coming years.

The objectives of this MOU are to:

- Provide on the job learning experience to current students through Cooperative Education Programs and Internships in the fields of Software Engineering, Information Technology, and Electronic Business
- Transfer knowledge on technology topics and trends to the students and faculty via presentations and seminars
- Present job opportunities to qualified PSU graduates.

The specific programs we wish to launch are as follows:

Cooperative Education Program

This will be a four month program in which the selected student will be given a specific business project to complete for course credit. The student will work full time from the OSCL offices under the supervision of a company manager/mentor. The scope of the project and its deliverables will be agreed on a mutual basis by the responsible PSU faculty member and OSCL management.

The program will seek to leverage the student's coursework and technical skills in a real world business environment. The goals of the program are to:

- Reinforce existing skills by deploying them toward a relevant business project
- Develop additional technical and business skills through interaction with business colleagues and independent study/research
- Teach the importance of project management and communication skills as success factors in the technology industry
- Provide the opportunity to demonstrate personal responsibility
- Enhance the student's future career prospects

This program will operate on an annual basis with at least one student chosen to participate during each of the school's four month terms. OSCL seeks to place its first student during the August to December, 2018 term and the next student during the January to May, 2019 term.

Before the end of the current term (May 2018), OSCL wishes to meet with faculty to identify suitable candidates and define appropriate projects. We mutually will agree on specific project(s) and deliverables for the chosen student(s). OSCL will assign a manager/mentor to work directly with the student. This manager will act as a liaison between OSCL and PSU providing regular status of the student's progress and performance. Upon completion of the program, the student will receive an official summary of the project and assessment of their performance on OSCL letterhead.

Internship Program

This will be a two to four month program in which the selected student will be assume a full time position within the company. The student will work full time from the OSCL offices under the supervision of a company manager/mentor. The role and responsibilities will be agreed on a mutual basis by the responsible PSU faculty member and OSCL management.

The program will seek to leverage the student's coursework and technical skills in a real world business environment. The goals of the program are to:

- Reinforce existing skills by deploying them in a traditional job setting
- Develop additional technical and business skills through interaction with business colleagues and independent study/research
- Gain experience in responding to changing business priorities
- Demonstrate the ability to function as a contributing team member
- Enhance the student's future career prospects

This program will operate on an annual basis with at least two students chosen to participate during the school year. OSCL seeks to place its first student starting from May, 2018 break.

Before the end of the current term (May 2018), OSCL wishes to meet with faculty to identify suitable candidates and define potential roles. We mutually will agree on the role description and responsibilities of the chosen student(s). OSCL will assign a manager/mentor to work directly with the student. This manager will act as a liaison between OSCL and PSU providing regular status of the student's progress and performance. Upon completion of the program, the student will receive an official summary of their internship experience and an assessment of their performance on OSCL letterhead.

General Knowledge Transfer Program

OSCL is pleased to provide its insights and perspectives on technology trends and topics to the broader PSU faculty and student population. This program could begin immediately. To this end the company would like to:

- Deliver at least one presentation per semester on the PSU campus. The topic of the presentation would be chosen jointly by PSU and OSCL based on its relevance to the students' course of study or areas of interest.
- Conduct an annual seminar for select students and faculty on an advanced topic. The topic of the presentation would be chosen by PSU from a list of advanced topics provided by OSCL. The seminar would be held on the PSU campus or at OSCL offices depending on the number of participants.


- Hold an annual open house event at the offices of OSCL in which students could observe the company's working environment and gain insights into the day to day operation of a technology company. The event would need to be structured so that a limited number of visitors would be scheduled to visit during specific time slots throughout the day.

Summary

OSCL looks forward to implementing these programs with PSU in the near future. We believe the program will provide significant benefits to the students and allow OSCL to get direct exposure to potential future employees.

ONE Software Company Limited is pleased to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding and looks forward to a long and mutually beneficial relationship with the Prince of Songkla University School of Technology and Environment.
