



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

SOJO UNIVERSITY

AND

PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, PHUKET CAMPUS

1) Preamble:

Acting on the principle of sincere cooperation and common development, SOJO University, Japan and Faculty of Technology and Environment, Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus, Thailand have agreed to enter into the following Agreement for the purpose of carrying out a joint educational cooperation and exchange program on the basis of equality and mutual benefits.

2) Objectives:

The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide a framework by which the parties may in future undertake joint activities together, which may include:

- 2.1 Exchange of students,
- 2.2 Exchange of academic materials, publications, and information,
- 2.3 To promote collaborations in research and education between the two universities.
- 2.4 To improve the quality of the education program of both parties, while laying a foundation for the development of a future International Program,
- 2.5 To provide opportunity for future training of teaching staff from both parties,
- 2.6 Other activities deemed mutually beneficial.

3) Terms of Memorandum:

This Agreement shall become effective immediately upon being signed by the official representatives of the two parties and shall remain valid for a period of five (5) years. This Agreement may be renewed for a further period of five (5) years by mutual agreement prior to the date of expiry.

4) Coordination of Agreed Activities:

In order to carry out and fulfill the aims of this Memorandum, each party will appoint a coordinator, who will be responsible for managing the development and conduct of any activities upon which the parties agree.
