**Subject: Admission for High School Graduates in 14 Southern Provinces
with Foreign Language Proficiency for the Academic Year 2021 (TCAS Round 2)**

Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus (PSU Phuket) is an international campus that serves as a regional education hub offering courses in English and other foreign languages, information technology, hospitality and tourism management, and environmental management for sustainable development. PSU Phuket would like to announce the admission process of 4 international undergraduate programs for high school students with foreign language proficiency for the academic year 2021 as follows:

1. Qualifications

- 1.1 Current senior high school student in the 14 southern province and will have completed high school in the academic year 2020 or a high school graduated or its equivalent;
- 1.2 Well-mannered;
- 1.3 Healthy and free from communicable diseases that can hinder the study;
- 1.4 Specific qualifications required by each faculty or program as detailed in the table below;
- 1.5 In case the applicant does not meet all the required qualifications 1.1-1.4 above, the applicant's admission application may be considered by the Admissions Committee on a case-by-case basis.

3. Application

Applicants must meet all the qualifications stated above in item 1. If the applicant lacks any of the qualifications or provided false information in the application, the University shall disqualify and terminate the application process.

3.1 Application process

3.1.1 For Thai applicants (using Thai identification card)

3.2 Application fee

There is no application fee for admission through this system.

4. Application documents

- 4.1 Current senior high school student in Mathayom 6 or equivalent:
 - One copy of academic transcript for 5 semesters.
- 4.2 High school graduate or equivalent:
 - One copy of high school diploma or its equivalent.
- 4.3 High school equivalency certificate:
 - One copy of GCE A-Level (General Certificate of Education Advanced Level) or Cambridge Pre-U or GED (General Educational Development) or IB (International Baccalaureate) Certificate.
- 4.4 One copy of certificate of Language Proficiency Test:
 - TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) or TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or HSK (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi) as required by the field of study.
- 4.5 One copy of identification card (for Thais) or passport (for non-Thais).

Remark: All documents must be signed by the applicant to certify that all copies are correct.

5. Selection Criteria

The University will appoint the Admissions Committee to assess and select qualified applicants as follows:

5.1 Applicants will be considered based on one of the following academic qualifications: current high school student still studying in Mathayom 6 (or equivalent) or have GCE A-Level (General Certificate of Education Advanced Level) or Cambridge Pre-U or GED (General Educational Development) or IB (International Baccalaureate) Certificate, and a certificate of Language Proficiency Test.

5.2 Interview score based on the following criteria:

5.2.1 Personality	10 points
5.2.2 Attitude towards the program	20 points
5.2.3 Communication skills	20 points
5.2.4 Summarizing skills	10 points
5.2.5 General knowledge on current events:	
- Social, arts, culture, and sports	20 points
- Economy and politics	20 points
Total	100 points

Remark: The interview will be conducted in Thai and/or English (depending on the field of study).

All decisions made by the Admissions Committee are final and are not subject to further review or appeal.

12. Conditions for Admission

High school students who are still studying in Mathayom 6 and have confirmed acceptance to study at PSU Phuket must continue studying and complete high school in the academic year 2020 to be fully eligible to study at the University.

13. Conditions for Graduation

- 13.1 Students must complete their studies and pass all course assessments specified by the program in accordance with Prince of Songkla University's regulations.
- 13.2 Students must pass standardized English Proficiency Test as specified by the University.
