Subject: Guidelines for Teaching, Learning, Assessment, and Evaluation
Management During the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Pandemic Situation for
Semester 1/2021 (Issue 2)

Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus recognizes the risks of the new wave of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak in Thailand and in Phuket; therefore, to prevent and curb the spreading of the infection, we would like to set the guidelines for teaching, learning, assessment, and evaluation management during the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic situation for Semester 1/2021, as follows:

1. All classes need to cease in-class teaching and learning activities from 9 August – 11 October, 2021 and switch to online teaching or another form that does not involve gathering of students in the classroom.
2. Refrain from conducting evaluations in the examination room. Lecturers should consider changing the measurement and evaluation format to a more formative assessment throughout the duration of learning in each course, in conjunction with other appropriate and effective forms of measurement and evaluation such as online exams, take-home exams, reflection, evaluation of activities or results, and so on.
3. Services on campus, in the faculties and colleges such as library, laboratory and reading area can be opened by strictly adhering to the D-M-H-T-T principle.
4. Some adjustments to the guidelines may be made to comply with Phuket's Coronavirus Disease Prevention and Control Measures Order 2019.
5. For cases other than those specified in this announcement, a request must be submitted to the Vice President of PSU Phuket Campus for consideration on a case-by-case basis.

This notice is effective until there is an announcement of any other changes.
